How can you tell the difference between a high security lock and an ordinary one? It's simple. The high security lock has Medeco written across its face.

High security starts with key control. If anyone can go down the street and make a copy of your key, it doesn't matter how tough the lock itself is. That's why Medeco locks are built smarter – starting with a level of protection against unauthorized key duplication that's so good it's patented.

That makes it virtually impossible for someone to duplicate your key without your permission.

Only Medeco security professionals are authorized to copy your key and only with your consent.

High security also means resistance to picking. Our specially designed pins must be elevated and rotated precisely before the lock will open. And our Medeco® technology adds

a third locking element – a slider mechanism – within the cylinder and on your key. Now the lock that set the industry standard for high security is even tougher to get into.

And of course, a high security lock must be tough – able to resist physical attack. Medeco cylinders have hardened-steel inserts strategically placed in seven locations to resist drilling. For thieves, it's all about access and time, and Medeco locks are designed to stop them at every turn.

PREMIUM HIGH SECURITY

Medeco keys are unique and require special key-cutting machines to precisely duplicate the right, left, and center angles. With factory milled side cuts on each key to align the unique slider, additional pick resistance is achieved by blocking the sidebar.

A Medeco key cannot be duplicated without the owner's authorization.

To resist drilling, we add hardened steel inserts to critical sections of the lock face and sidebar.

A third locking mechanism, the sidebar, can only operate when the tumblers are properly aligned.

Once the slider is in the correct position, the Medeco pick-resistant pin tumblers must be elevated and rotated to the proper position for the lock cylinder to operate.

STANDARD SECURITY

A common key can be cut at any corner store and has no provisions for controlled duplication.

The lock cylinder, with no hardened steel inserts, offers little protection against drilling.

Common pins are vulnerable to picking.
